

Webb Road Congregation Helps Can Hunger in Wichita

In January 2004, the Webb Road Community of Christ congregation in Wichita, Kansas, hosted a *Hunger Challenge* for Jr. and Sr. High youth. Hunger Challenge is a nationwide effort by youth to help those who are less fortunate by raising funds to support the work of Outreach International among the world's poor.

Forty-one young people from around the community participated in the week-end event to experience what it was like to be hungry, while raising funds and having fun in the process. On Saturday afternoon the group divided into nine teams to participate in a "Let's Can Hunger" Scavenger Hunt.

They raised an impressive amount of canned food items for the Kansas Food Pantry in Wichita. The overnight activities included a live band, karaoke, games, movies and door prizes. Classroom activities provided the young people opportunities to learn more about world hunger and what they can do about it. Together, the group raised more than \$1,500 to help the poor in the many places where Outreach International works.
